




Cumulative Job Growth in U.S.




Birth of Manufacturing Firms 500 + Employees





2010-2050







Cultivating & Retaining talent:


- ☐ Talent is footloose, especially at a certain life stage. But ...






Seven Key Factors of Primacy of Place








